

Our goal is to provide campers with a clean and safe environment where you can make memories with family and friends.

We are obligated to follow the local codes and regulations for campgrounds.

The following rules are enforced to ensure the campground is well managed and in compliance with all government regulations.

Boats

Boats may be stored in a designated staging area. Boats are not safe to store on site in season because campfires, gas cans and trailers are not a good mix.

Children

Oneida Pines Campground and staff are not responsible for watching children at any time

Children under 16 must have adult supervision at all times and be on the site they belong to every night by Dusk!

All children must wear a bicycle helmet when riding bicycles on the property

Children must wear life jackets when fishing at the pond and be accompanied by an adult.

Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age at the swimming pool

Children age 16 or under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible person over the age of 16 at the pond area and hiking trails.

Battery operated cars for children are strictly prohibited here at Oneida Pines campground.

Campfires

Campfires must remain inside your fire ring and should be no more than 2 feet high. The management will extinguish your campfire if it is more than 2 feet tall.

Clutter

Your site must be free from clutter all year long

Decks

Decks may only be 8, wide and cannot extend the length of the unit.

Site built additions or roofs over decks are not permitted

Fiberglass or aluminum hard top awnings and aluminum screen rooms are permitted

Electric water & Sewer

Electric is metered \$0.24 per KWH plus sales tax of 8.75% applies.

Electric bills are issued on the first of every month and due by the 15th.

If bills are over due by 30 days a 1.5% late fee will be added to the account.

After 60 days delinquent your gate key will be deactivated and your electric service will be disconnected. In order to restore electric service your account must be brought current, a reconnect fee of 20.00 will be charged and a deposit of 300.00 must be made at that time. The deposit will be applied to future electric usage.
Water and sewer are included for the season.

Firewood

Firewood is available at the camp store

Due to NY state law, firewood must be harvested within a 50 mile radius and documentation must be present and kept on file.

firewood piles are limited to 3 face cord per site. (a face cord is 4'X8)' at any time. If any wood is trucked into this campground the proper certificate must be provided!

Firearms

Are not permitted at Oneida Pines Campground

Fireworks

Fireworks are not allowed anywhere at any time in the park

Gate passes

We are happy to issue two access cards per site.

A 10.00 deposit is required for gate passes. when the passes are returned in the same condition they were issued you will receive your 10.00 deposit back.

Passes remain active indefinitely unless there is a balance due on your account of 30 days. The pass will be deactivated until your account is current.

Glass bottles

No glass bottles allowed on the campground anywhere, pool, pavilion rec hall or just walking around.

Golf Carts

Electric Golf carts only

NO person under 16 years old is permitted to operate a golf cart at Oneida Pines Campground

NO ATV's allowed

Inspection

All units are subject to approval by management

Hunting

Never permitted on the property

Lost or stolen items

We are not responsible for lost or stolen items

Maintenance

Seasonal Campers must mow their own sites. If you wish for the campground to mow your site we will arrange it for 20.00 per cut.

If the site is neglected Oneida Pines management will have the site cut and billed 30.00 to your account.

Mail boxes

Located in the rec hall

Please check weekly for updated events, notices and **Electric Bills**

Noise level

Please be considerate of your fellow campers

Quiet time begins at 10:00 pm.

Bands and Dj can go to 11 pm on Saturdays.

When returning to you site please be considerate of your neighbors.

Parking

There is only enough room to park two cars at a time per site.

Additional parking is available near the camp store.

Pets

Maximum of 2 animals per site
Must produce a copy of current rabies vaccination
Must be on a leash at all times
Must clean up after your pet
Dog houses and pens are not allowed
Exercise pens that collapse are acceptable
If your dog barks and becomes a nuisance for your neighbors, attend to the dog promptly or you will be asked to remove the dog from the campground.

Pond

For use by all registered campers
Fishing-Please catch & release
Children must wear life vests while fishing or playing near the pond
Recreation areas
Supervise your children, be careful and safe
Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an responsible person over the age of 16
be careful and safe

Return any borrowed items to the store after using them
please advise staff if you notice any damage or see something missing.

Refrigerators and freezers

Full size refrigerators and freezers are not allowed to be exposed outside of a camper or a shed.

Roof shoveling

Can be arranged, must contact the office at 315-245-1377, an additional fee will be charged based on snow load.

Sanitation

Dumpsters are located between the rec hall and the front bathrooms.

Please recycle using the smaller dumpster for recyclables, the larger for trash.

Please bag your returnable cans and bottles.

When disposing of fish guts place them in a zip lock bag, double bag with a second zip lock bag and kindly place them in the freezer located next to the back door of the rec hall.

Seasonal lease agreement

The seasonal lease agreement can be up to four adults and three children. a total of seven humans and two pets.

Example: Mr. and Mrs Smith rent site 1, on site one the seasonal will be Mr and Mrs Smith, their two good friends the Jennings who drop in from time to time may be added too their lease the Jennings will not have to pay they can come and go as they please. The Smiths may also include their three children.

If the Smiths had five children then Mr and Mrs Smith would be the only two adults on the lease and the five children would make up the remaining 5 humans on their lease agreement.

If you would like more seasonal guests on your lease, that is simple. Just register them and pay 60.00 per adult and 40.00 per child over the age of six.

Everyone who enters the campground must register and sign a liability waiver or they could be considered to be trespassing.

Monthly rates

850.00 including the electric full hook up

2 consecutive months or more is 550.00 per month plus electric

Weekly rates are

325.00 including the electric full hook up

Nightly rates

55.00 per night including the electric full hook up

Visitors

We have two kinds of visitors, overnight visitors and day campers

Day visitor passes for adults can be purchased by seasonal guests at the store in advance, or the visitors may register and pay their own entry fee.

Overnight guests are 10.00 per night for adults (anyone 18 or over and 5.00 per night for children 7-17)

Day Visitors are 6.00 per adult 18 years and over

3.00 for teens 13-17 years

2.00 for children 7-12 years

Day visitors can use all the facilities but must be here with a seasonal or overnight registered guest to a specific site.

The public cannot drop in from the outside just to use the facilities.

Oneida Pines will give each site 10 free guest passes per season.

(That is one pass per visitor, not one per couple and not one pass per car with more than one visitor entering the park)
